### Challenge

Kennesaw Crossing is located at 1650 N Roberts Road in Kennesaw, Georgia. Partnering with NBA, our goals of the project were to make sure that construction documents were correctly coordinated, questions and comments were responded to in a timely manner, and the end design was of high-grade and profitable for the owner. The project consisted of 3 Type VA apartment buildings all equipped with a 13R sprinkler system, except for the amenity spaces which contained a full 13 sprinkler. The overall design presented challenges that included handling the buildings' fire ratings, creating some aesthetically pleasing amenity spaces with high ceilings, and reassuring the client of a high-quality end design. Due to changes in NBA's design team staff, the client was uncertain if there were going to be issues with the delivery of the design and the finished product.

## Approach



In order to prevent the stair shafts and much of the adjoining structure from requiring a 2-hour fire rating, the design team provided an open area at the exit stairs to allow them to be classified as "open stairs", allowing the enclosure to only be 1-hour rated.
